

Kennedy Park

On a visit to Kennedy Park you are likely to find all woodpecker species in our area. Piliated, Hairy, Downy, Red Bellied, Red Headed, Yellow Bellied Sapsucker, and Northern Flicker

Boardwalk area

Runs from parking area to Greenway Trail bottomland trail likely to have chickadees, sparrows, brown creepers, towhees etc...

Greenway Trail

Runs from Raleigh Lagrange to Wolf River Boat Ramp near Harrington Creek likely to see almost any species from Raleigh CBC list except for open water duck species (i.e. ringnecked duck, bufflehead, etc...)

Disk Golf Course

Meanders through the woods along the main park road and around the first set of ball fields, similar habitat to Boardwalk area

Greenway Connector from Elmore

Runs from Elmore Rd Dead End to Greenway Trail at Harrington Creek, starts off adjacent to a slough then follows a ridge along the Wolf River. Likely species include wood duck, phoebe, sparrows, yellow rump warblers, possibly gulls.

Construction Area

Likely species in this area include killdeer, doves, raptors
