

Raleigh Civic Center

The Raleigh Civic Center replaced the old Raleigh Springs Mall with a new library branch and Memphis Police Precinct building. While there are typically not a large number of birds present, this place does have some species that aren't as likely to be found at other stops of the Raleigh CBC Route <u>buffleheads being the main species</u>

Lakes

Since this space was reinvented by the city a few years ago, in the winter the lakes have hosted Buffleheads that have stayed all winter long. As of the first week of December 2023 there were 6 Buffleheads hanging out on the lakes. There has been a lone snow goose for about a week also.

Big Field

Depending on he time of day Canada Geese and killdeer are likely in the big field, Eastern Bluebirds are also a normal species to see in this area.

Lawn by Skate Park

At times, a variety of blackbirds can be observed on the lawn near the skate park

Tree Line

A walk along the tree line will typically turn up Cardinals and White Throated Sparrows in the winter, towhees, and Pine warblers are possible too.
